

London Environmental Network – Membership Policy

The London Environmental Network (LEN) helps protect our environment and build a sustainable community by doing everything we can to help our member organizations deliver on each of their own important missions.

The London Environmental Network provides our member organizations with shared resources, and training, outreach and collaboration opportunities so they can become stronger and work more effectively together. We also connect groups to the London community, recruits volunteers, and promotes environmental events, initiatives and successes.

LEN membership includes three categories: Member Organization, Associate Member and Sustainer.

Membership Criteria:

Member Organizations must:

- Be a nonprofit organization, which may include any nonprofit corporation, association or network (incorporated or unincorporated) which have the following characteristics:
- Have their main location, a branch of operations or a base of operations be within London or surrounding areas
- Have their own decision making process
- Ensure any profit made is not distributed to the members
- Exist to serve an environmental benefit (or at least a strong focus on environmental programs, actions and activities)
- Follow LEN's Members' Code of Behaviour
- Complete a Member application and be ratified by our Steering Committee

Termination of Membership

Will be determined by the Steering Committee as needs arise.

Membership Code of Conduct

Associate Member

Can be a business, co-operative, educational institution, social enterprise etc. that has an interest in environmental activities.

Sustainer

Any sponsor, funder, grantor or donor.
